



Fall 2021 Pre-College Program Schuylkill Campus courses

BIO 109/C/PC06 (3 credits)- Human Biology

Tuesdays and Thursdays, 2pm-3:20pm

An introductory course with emphasis on human physiology and the role humans play in biosphere. Application of biological principles to practical human concerns are covered in one semester.

COM 101/C/PC06 (3 credits)- Composition and Research

Mondays and Wednesdays, 9:30am-11:00am

Core writing requirement, reviews fundamental principles of rhetoric, grammar, punctuation and spelling. Requirements include a research paper using MLA documentation guidelines and several expository papers. Course is available only after placement by departmental faculty. Students must achieve "C" or better to fulfill core requirements.

HIS 112/C/PC06 (3 credits)- The Study of American History

Mondays and Wednesdays. 2pm-3:20pm

Introduces student to the chronology of American history, a broad selection of key documents, appropriate secondary reading materials, and descriptions of selected key events in the evolution of American history.

PSY 101/C/PC06 (3 credits)- Introductory Psychology

Tuesdays and Thursdays, 9:30am-11am

Introduction to major concepts and findings in psychology with emphasis on basic processes underlying human behavior.

All courses are offered both through a live zoom class AND in person. The students must be logged on during these assigned days and times as the professor will be teaching live to other students through zoom and in the classroom from our Schuylkill Campus.
